NEW EXPANSION FOR PEMBROKE GETS APPROVAL

PEMBROKE has secured approval for a \$25 million upgrade of its Kensington Park middle school campus, including a new footbridge spanning Shipsters Rd.

The campus will expand to the old Kensington Centre special school, on the western side of Shipsters Rd, which Pembroke bought for \$4 million in 2015.

The project will includes a new science, technology and art centre, and a fully-enclosed footbridge to connect school sites on both sides of Shipsters Rd. Demolition of the existing buildings was expected to get underway at the end of July

PEREGRINE'S \$50 MILLION PARADE TOWER GIVEN APPROVAL



The Peregrine corporation's proposed new headquarters has been given development approval despite representations and objections issued by this association, residents and local government.

The approved proposal did reduce in height slightly however the proposed solution still remains a significant building within the local context.

The KRA has since written to the Independent Commissioner Against Corruption to question the probity of the approval process after the planning minister recused himself from making decisions around approvals despite granting the project major project status.

REFURBISHING THE KENSINGTON AND NORWOOD POOL

As the proposal to refurbish the Kensington and Norwood pool enters its next phase of public consultation a vote was held at a recent Council meeting on the operation of the pool. A proposal was put forward to reduce the operating hours of the pool. Thanks to campaigning on behalf of residents, this Association and Cr Christel Mex the council saw fit to reject the proposal and continue the pools operation with operating hours unchanged. Congratulations to the city of NPSP on a common sense approach to this process.
