Guidelines

We think Kensington is the best place to live and we hope you do too.

We announce that **two community grants** are available to be spent this year—2023 for the benefit of the Kensington community.

The grants

Adults (18 and over): a grant of up to \$750 is available.

Children (under 18): a grant of up to \$250 is available.

Who is eligible?

Anyone living in Kensington or on its perimeter roads and a member of the Association (or living in a member household).

Who is not eligible?

Committee members of the KRA and their family members.

What are the grants for?

Any project that benefits our fabulous suburb! It may be environmental, cultural, artistic, social, even virtual.

Projects with a clear benefit to our community (not just benefitting a few individuals) will be viewed favourably.

Grant funds must be used for project expenses. Hours worked by grant recipients is not a valid expense.

How do I apply?

Non-members may join on payment of our \$15 annual fee.

Applications to be received by the end of May 2023 with successful recipients to be notified in June. Funds must be expended by the end of 2023.
